A cookie is widely used to help a with your user experience and with navigation. A cookie is a file that is stored on your computer when you visit a website. When you revisit the website later or visit a different webpage a copy of the cookie file is sent to the website so that it remembers you have already visited before.

Managing cookies in your browser

Most modern browsers will allow you to:

- See what cookies you've got and delete them on an individual basis.
- Block third party cookies.
- Block cookies from particular sites.
- Block all cookies from being set.
- Delete all cookies when you close your browser.

You should be aware that any preferences will be lost if you delete cookies. Ironically, this includes where you have opted out from cookies, as this requires an opt-out cookie to be set. Also, if you block cookies completely many websites will not work properly and some functionality on these websites will not work at all. We do not recommend turning cookies off when using the digital products and services within All 4 for these reasons. If you are primarily concerned about third party cookies generated by advertisers, you can turn these off separately. This is discussed in more detail below.
